Master of Philosophy (M.Phil Programme in Education)

M.Phil. Programme is a crucial preparatory programme for prospective researchers at the pre-doctoral level. The programme is designed to give students a firm grounding in educational research and build conceptual foundations in specific areas of advanced studies in education. It is intended for students with professional goals as educational practitioners in various settings, which may include careers as college and university faculty, researchers, managers and development autonomous professionals government, non-government and research in organizations and development agencies; policy analysts, planners, educational consultants; academic and professional leaders in the school system etc.

About the Programme

The programme has two parts which is designed with the objective of enhancing students' conceptual and analytical understanding of educational theory and practice. Part I comprises of a compulsory course in Research Methodology and two optional courses in diverse areas of Education. Part-II of the programme constitutes of research work leading to a Dissertation.

Medium of Instruction

The medium of instruction is English. Depending on the need of the scholars, the faculty members interact in a bilingual mode. However, candidates will be permitted to take their examination either, in English or Hindi.

Eligibility Criteria

Master's Degree of an Indian University or an equivalent degree of a Foreign University in Education or an Allied Subject* with a Second Class i.e. minimum of 55% marks in the aggregate or an equivalent grade.

* Allied Subjects:

Psychology, Child Development, Sociology, Anthropology, Social Work, Linguistics, Philosophy, Physical Education/Health Education, Human Development, Lifelong Learning, Mathematics Education, Early Childhood Care Education, Gender Studies.

Note: Rounding off of fraction is not allowed while computing the percentage of marks of eligibility.

Admission to the M.Phil. Programme is governed by the Amendments to Ordinances VI, VI-A and VI-B (M.Phil. and Ph.D.) dated August 9, 2017 of the University of Delhi.

Total Number of Seats: 25 (Twenty-Five)

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be done as per Rules of University of Delhi.

In a year, foreign nationals may be registered over and above the maximum admissible strength provided they fulfil the eligibility criteria. However, at any given time, the total number of foreign students is not to exceed 10% of the total admissible strength.

All candidates seeking admission to the M.Phil. Programme are required to register online on **www.du.ac.in**

- Applicants are required to upload their Research Area and a Research proposal
 while registering online. <u>Applications without Research Area and a Research</u>
 proposal will be considered incomplete and will be rejected.
- In case a candidate wishes to apply to both the Ph.D. and the M.Phil. Programmes, there is no need to fill two separate registration forms for M.Phil and Ph.D. Such candidates should tick on the option *Both M.Phil and Ph.D* given in the registration form. Further, such candidates will have to make payment of only Rs. 750/ (concession for EWS/SC/ST/PwD categories remain applicable).

- Eligibility for appearing in the written examination/ interview is subject to the candidate fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed. Process for Selection of Candidates

As per Bulletin of information of M.Phil. / Ph.D. admission 2021, University of Delhi. .

All candidates must fill in the online application form.

Candidates without a UGC NET in Education will have to first appear in an Entrance Test (DUET). Candidates who score minimum 50% of marks in the DUET, will then be called for one or two levels of interview for final recommendation for admission to the Programme..

Candidates with a UGC NET in Education do not have to appear for the written test (DUET). Such candidates will be directly called to appear for one or two levels of interview for final recommendation for admission to the Programme.

Candidates with a NET certificate in other subjects will have to take the DUET.

The Syllabus for the Entrance Test will consist of 50% questions from Research Aptitude/Methodology and 50% subject-specific questions from the
