Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Programme in Education

The Doctoral Programme in Education aims to develop an understanding of research, public policy and educational theory and practice, and the relationships among them. It begins with a study of specific courses followed by rigorous research leading to a dissertation.

The course work gives students the opportunity to study individualized courses that are tailored to suit their research interests. These could be a combination of courses designed within the Department of Education and those chosen from courses across disciplines offered by other departments of the University of Delhi, including courses on qualitative and quantitative research methods. The doctoral program is based on the premise that rigorous research will help develop a cadre of professionals who can develop specialised knowledge in areas of educational practice and public policy. The programme prepares students to assume roles as university faculty members, senior-level educational leaders, professional practitioners, policy makers, and researchers.

Prospective students should look into the research interests of the Department/Faculty, and discuss courses that can be offered in order to complete the application for admission.

Eligibility Conditions:

The candidate must have obtained a Masters or an M.Phil. Degree in Education of the University of Delhi, or any other recognized University to be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

The candidate must have obtained either a minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in the M.Phil. Degree or a minimum of 55% marks or an equivalent grade in the Masters degree in Education.

Note: Rounding off of fraction is not allowed while computing the percentage of marks of eligibility.

Admission to the Ph.D. Programme is governed by the Amendments to Ordinances VI, VI-A and VI-B (M.Phil. and Ph.D.) dated August 9, 2017 of the University of Delhi.

Total Number of Seats: 38 (Thirty-Eight)

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWD candidates will be done as per Rules of University of Delhi.

In a year, foreign nationals may be registered over and above the maximum admissible strength provided they fulfil the eligibility criteria. However, at any given time, the total number of foreign students should not exceed 10% of the total admissible strength.

Admission Procedure

- All candidates seeking admission to the Ph.D. Programme are required to register online on <u>www.du.ac.in</u>
- Applicants are required to upload their Research Area and a Research proposal while registering online. <u>Applications without Research Area and a Research</u> <u>proposal will be considered incomplete and will be rejected.</u>

In case a candidate wishes to apply to both the Ph.D. and the M.Phil. Programmes, there is no need to fill two separate registration forms for M.Phil and Ph.D. Such candidates should tick on the option *Both M.Phil and Ph.D* given in the registration form. Further, such candidates will have to make payment of only Rs. 750/ (concession for EWS/SC/ST/PwD categories remain applicable).

- Eligibility for appearing in the written examination/ interview is subject to the candidate fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed. In case a candidate does not meet these minimum eligibility criteria and appears in the written examination/interview, it is at the candidate's own risk and cost, and if at any stage, it is found that the minimum eligibility requirements are not fulfilled, the admission, if granted, shall be cancelled ipso facto.

Process for Selection of Candidates

As per Bulletin of information of M.Phil./Ph.D. admission 2021, University of Delhi. All candidates must fill in the online application form.

Candidates without a UGC NET in Education will have to first appear in an Entrance Test (DUET). Candidates who score minimum 50% of marks in the DUET, will then be called for one or two levels of interview for final recommendation for admission to the Programme..

Candidates with a UGC NET in Education do not have to appear for the written test (DUET). Such candidates will be directly called to appear for one or two levels of interview for final recommendation for admission to the Programme..

Candidates with a NET certificate in other subjects will have to take the DUET.

The Syllabus for the Entrance Test will consist of 50% questions from Research Aptitude/Methodology and 50% subject-specific questions from the following areas:

- Sociology of Education
- Psychology of Education
- History-Political Economy of Education
